

riority No. 47; that said ditch is owned by Isaac Sanders; that said ditch is used for the irrigation of five (5) acres of land; that said ditch takes its water from the North Fork of Hardscrabble Creek; and that there be allowed to flow into said ditch, for the use of the owner thereof, under and by virtue of priority No. 306, one half of one cubic foot of water per second of time for one day in each eight days, or for such less time as shall be sufficient for the irrigation of said five acres of land, the day to be chosen at a time when the Lewis Lower Ditch is not entitled to take water from said North Fork of said Hardscrabble Creek.

No. 330—The John Spalding Ditch No. 2.

That said ditch is entitled to Arkansas River priority No. 309, which is also Oak Creek priority No. 16; that said ditch is owned by John Spalding; that said ditch takes its water from Willow Creek, a tributary to Oak Creek, and its headgate is located on the north side of said creek at a point North 75 degrees E, 500 feet, from the $\frac{3}{4}$ section corner on the West side of section 20, Tp. 21 S, R 70 West; that said ditch is used for the irrigation of ten (10) acres of land; and that there be allowed to flow into said ditch, for the use of the owner thereof, under and by virtue of priority No. 309, fifty-four one hundredths of one cubic foot of water per second of time for and during such time and times as is sufficient for the irrigation of said ten acres of ground.

No. 331—The Gardner Ditch No. 4.

That said ditch is entitled to Arkansas River priority No. 310, which is also main Tallahassee Creek
