

That said ditch is entitled to Arkansas River priorities No's 312 and 394, which are also Howard Creek priorities No's 14 and 17; that said ditch is owned by L. H. Mains; that the headgate of said ditch is situate on the West side of said creek at a point to find which commence at the quarter section corner on the line between sections 12 and 13 Tp. 48 N; R 9 East, run thence S, 705 feet, thence West 238 feet to headgate; that said ditch is used for the irrigation of fifty (50) acres of land; and that there be allowed to flow into said ditch for the use of the owner thereof, under and by virtue of priority No. 312, one cubic foot of water per second of time for and during such time and times as is sufficient for the irrigation of thirteen acres of land; and that there be further allowed to flow into said ditch, constantly during the irrigation season, and under and by virtue of said priority No. 394, the further quantity of one and forty-eight hundredths (1.48) cubic feet of water per second of time.

No. 334—The Woodriff-Tells Ditch.

That said ditch is entitled to Arkansas River priorities No's 313 and 399; that Daniel T. Woodriff is the owner of one third of said ditch, G. W. Kendrick and M. T. Kendrick the owners of one third thereof, George Bolt the owner of five twenty-fourths thereof, Otto Dupp the owner of two twenty-fourths thereof, and Annie E. Hamilton the owner of one twenty-fourth thereof; that said ditch takes its water from the Arkansas River, and its headgate is situate at a point from which the South East corner of section 26, Tp. 19 S, R 68 West bears S. 2 degrees and
