No. 336—The McCandless Ditch.

That said ditch is entitled to Arkansas River priority No. 318; that said ditch is owned by The Florence Oil and Refining Company; that its headgate is on the North bank of the Arkansas River at a point found by running from the North West corner of Section 15, Tp. 19 S, R 69 West, S 74 degrees and 30 minutes East, 2,500 feet; that said ditch is used for the irrigation of twenty-five (25) acres of land; and that there be allowed to flow into said ditch for the use and benefit of the owners thereof, under and by virtue of said priority No. 318, constantly during the irrigation season, one cubic foot of water per second of time.

No. 337—The Greenwood Ditch.

That said ditch is entitled to Arkansas River priority No. 318, which is also Hardscrabble Creek priority No. 52; that said ditch is owned by James W. Bowers, who owns an undivided one third thereof, and that one Lewis, who owns an undivided two thirds thereof; that said ditch is used for the irrigation of five (5) acres of land; that said ditch takes water from Hardscrabble Creek and its headgates is situate on the West side of said creek; and that there be allowed to flow into said ditch, for the use and benefit of the owners thereof, under and by virtue of said priority No. 318, one half of one cubic foot of water per second of time during one day in each eight days, the time to be chosen, as far as possible,
