

so as to be at times when the ditches having older priorities and which are allowed water only a part of the time, are not using water.

No. 338—The Island Ditch.

That said ditch is entitled to Arkansas River priority No. 318, which is also Beaver Creek priority No. 48; that said ditch is owned by Leverett S. Perry; that said ditch is used for the irrigation of seven (7) acres of land; that there be allowed to flow into said ditch, for the use of said Perry, under and by virtue of said priority No. 318, one cubic foot of water per second of time for and during such time and times as is sufficient for the irrigation of said seven acres of land; and that the quantity of water hereinbefore decreed to The Island Ditch No. 1 be also allowed to flow into this ditch, under and by virtue of priority No. 200, and through the same to said The Island Ditch No. 1.

No. 339—The Gader Ditch.

That said ditch is entitled to Arkansas River priorities No's 319 and 395, which are also Texas Creek priorities No's 88 and 114, Brush Creek priorities No's 36 and 50, and South Brush Creek priorities No's 14 and 20; that said ditch is owned by Frank Gader; that the headgate of said ditch is situate on the South side of South Brush Creek in the S. W. $\frac{1}{4}$ of the N. E. $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 23, Tp. 46 N, R 12; that said ditch is used for the irrigation of ninety-four (94) acres of land; that there be allowed to flow into said ditch, constantly, for the use of said owner thereof, under and by virtue of priority No. 319, two and three hundred and sixty-eight thousandths (2,368)
