

No. 345—The Fremont Water Supply Company's Canal.

That said canal is entitled to Arkansas River priority No. 330, which is also Beaver Creek priority No. 50; that the owner of said canal is The Fremont Water Supply Company; that the rights of said ditch cannot be fixed at this time in as much as the testimony does not disclose what they are.

No. 346—The John Spalding Ditch No. 4.

That said ditch is entitled to Arkansas River priority No. 331, which is also Oak Creek priority No. 18, and the second priority on Willow Creek; that said ditch is owned by John Spalding; that said ditch takes its water from said Willow Creek, a tributary of said Oak Creek, and its headgate is situate on the South side thereof at a point S. 5 degrees W. 650 feet from the N. E. corner of the S. E.  $\frac{1}{4}$  of the N. W.  $\frac{1}{4}$  of Sec. 20, Tp. 21 S, R 70 West; that said ditch is used for the irrigation of one and one half acres of land; and that there be allowed to flow into said ditch for the use of said owner thereof, under and by virtue of priority No. 331, fifty one hundredths (0.51) of one cubic foot of water per second of time for and during such time and times as is sufficient for the irrigation of said one and one half acres of land.

No. 347—The Lanoue Ditch.

That said ditch is entitled to Arkansas River priority No. 338, which is also Hayden Creek priority No. 16; that said ditch is owned by Alfred Lanoue and James C. Clayborn, each of whom owns an un-
