

divided one half thereof; that said ditch takes its water from said Hayden Creek and its headgate is situate on the West side thereof; that said ditch is used for the irrigation of thirty-five (35) acres of land owned by said Lanoue; and that there be allowed to flow into said ditch, constantly during the irrigation season, for the use of said Lanoue, under and by virtue of priority No. 338, one and four tenths cubic feet of water per second of time.

No. 348—The David Ditch.

That said ditch is entitled to Arkansas River priority Nos 338 and 355, which are also Currant Creek priorities No's — and —; that said ditch is owned by Washington L. Sweeney; that said ditch is used for the irrigation of twenty-four (24) acres of land; that there be allowed to flow into said ditch, for the use of said owner thereof, under and by virtue of priority No. 338, one cubic foot of water per second of time for and during such time and times as is sufficient for the irrigation of fifteen (15) acres of land; and that said amount of water be allowed to flow into said ditch under and by virtue of priority No. 355 for such additional time and times as is sufficient for the irrigation of nine (9) acres of land. Provided, however, that as between this ditch and the other ditches taking water from said Currant Creek and mentioned in a certain agreement concerning same herein filed the rights of the said The David Ditch shall be hereinafter decreed.

No. 349—Felch's West Side Ditch.

That said ditch is entitled to Arkansas River priority No. 339, which is also Four Mile Creek prior-
