

ity No. 75; that said ditch is owned by Marshall P. Felch, Mrs. Maria Hunt having a right from him to irrigate one acre therefrom; that the headgate of said ditch is on the West side of said Four Mile Creek in the S. W. $\frac{1}{4}$ of the N. E. $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 21, Tp. 17 S, R 70 West; that said ditch is used for the irrigation of twenty-three acres of land owned by said Felch and one acre owned by said Maria Hunt; and that there be allowed to flow into said ditch, constantly during the irrigation season, under and by virtue of said priority No. 339, ninety-six hundredths (0.96) of one cubic foot of water per second of time.

No. 350—The Houle Ditch No. 4.

That said ditch is entitled to Arkansas River priorities No's 339, and 391, which are also Texas Creek priorities No's 92 and 110, Brush Creek priorities No's 37 and 47 and North Brush Creek priorities No's 10 and 12; that said ditch is owned by Elizabeth Houle; that said ditch takes water from the natural stream, West Brush Creek, and its headgate is situate on the East side thereof at a point N. 53 degrees E, distant 600 feet, from the S. W. corner of the N. W. $\frac{1}{4}$ of the S. E. $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 14, Tp. 46, N, R 12 East; that said ditch is used for the irrigation of five (5) acres of land; that there be allowed to flow into said ditch, for the use of the owner thereof, under and by virtue of priority No. 339, one cubic foot of water per second of time for and during such time and times is sufficient for the irrigation of three (3) acres of land; and that said amount of water be further allowed to flow in said ditch for such additional time and times, under and by virtue of priority No. 391, as is sufficient for the irrigation of two (2) acres of land.
