

riority No. 342, which is also Four Mile Creek priority No. 76; that said ditch is owned by John O'Brien; that said ditch takes its water from said Four Mile Creek, and its headgate is situate on the S. W. $\frac{1}{4}$ of the S. E. $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 6, Tp. 15 S, R 71 West; that said ditch is used for the irrigation of fifteen (15) acres of land; and that there be allowed to flow into said ditch, for the use of the owner thereof, under and by virtue of said priority No. 342 one cubic foot of water per second of time for and during such time and times as is sufficient for the irrigation of said fifteen acres of land.

No. 353—The McGregor Ditch.

That said ditch is entitled to Arkansas River priority No. 345, which is also Oak Creek priority No. 20, and is the third priority on Willow Creek, a tributary of said Oak Creek; that said ditch is owned by Robert McGregor; that the head of said ditch is situate at a point whence the West $\frac{1}{4}$ corner of Section 20, Tp. 21 S, R 70 West bears S. 72 degrees and 18 minutes West. 2757 feet; that said ditch is used for the irrigation of fourteen (14) acres of land; and that there be allowed to flow into said ditch, for the use of said owner, under an by virtue of priority No. 345, one cubic foot of water per second of time for and during such time and times as is sufficient for the irrigation of said fourteen acres of land.

No. 354—The Caughman Ditch No. 2.

That said ditch is entitled to Arkansas River priority No. 346, which is also Texas Creek priority No. 96; that Seaborn Caughman is the sole owner of said ditch; that the headgate of said ditch is situate on
