

inches wide at the bottom 4 inches deep, and has a grade of 8 inches to the rod; and that there be allowed to flow into said ditch, for the use of the owner thereof, under and by virtue of said priority No. 347, so much water as said ditch will carry, for as many periods, in each year, not exceeding three, of one day each, as may be necessary to irrigate one acre of land; and that said amount of water be allowed to flow into said ditch for as many additional periods, not exceeding three, of three days each, as may be necessary to irrigate three acres of land.

No. 356—The South Squaw Ditch.

That said ditch is entitled to Arkansas River priorities No's 347, 357 and 377, which are also Cottonwood Creek priorities No's 19, 21 and 22; that, David Endsley is the owner of said ditch; that the head-gate of said ditch is situate at the North West corner of the S. W. $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 5, Tp. 17, S. R 73 West; that said ditch is 18 inches wide at the top, 9 inches wide at the bottom; five and one half inches deep, and has a grade of 8 inches to the rod; that said ditch is used for the irrigation of ten (10) acres of land; and that there be allowed to flow into said ditch, under and by virtue of said priority No. 347, so much water as said ditch will carry for as many periods, in each year, not exceeding three, of six days each, as may be necessary to irrigate six acres of plowed land; and that said amount of water be allowed to flow into said ditch, under and by virtue of said priority No. 357, for as many additional periods, not exceeding four, of one day each, as may be necessary to irrigate two acres of meadow land; and that said amount of water be still further allowed to flow in said ditch under and by virtue of said priority No. 377, for as
