

many additional periods, not exceeding four, of one day each, as may be necessary to irrigate two acres of meadow land.

No. 357—The Ute Park Ditch & Reservoir.

That said ditch and reservoir are not yet completed, and it is therefore impossible, at this time, to determine their rights.

No. 358—The Smith Ditch.

That said ditch is entitled to Arkansas River priority No. 352, which is also the first priority on Brush Creek in Brush Hollow; that said ditch is owned by M. J. Milsom and C. C. Smith; that the headgate of said ditch is situate about, or on, the line between the North East quarter and the North West quarter of the North East quarter of Sec. 36, Tp. 18 S, R 69 West; that said ditch is used for the irrigation of thirty (30) acres of land; and that there be allowed to flow into said ditch, constantly during the irrigation season, under and by virtue of said priority No. 352, one and two tenths (1.2) cubic feet of water per second of time.

No. 359—The Second Bernard Ditch.

That said ditch is entitled to Arkansas River priority No. 353, which is also Four Mile Creek priority No. 80; that said ditch takes its water from Bernard Creek and that the mouth of said Bernard Creek is so located that this ditch is not subject to any priority on West Four Mile Creek nor any priority on Four Mile Creek above the mouth of said Bernard Creek; that the headgate of said ditch is at the dam
