

of the first Bernard Ditch hereinbefore mentioned; that John R. Witcher is the owner of said ditch; that said ditch is used for the irrigation of three (3) acres of garden; and that there be allowed to flow into said ditch, for the use and benefit of said Witcher, under and by virtue of said priority, one cubic foot of water per second of time for and during such time and times as is sufficient for the irrigation of said three acres of garden.

No. 360—The Eight Mile Ditch.

That said ditch is entitled to Arkansas River priorities No's 353 and 391, which are also Eight Mile Creek priorities No's 10 and 12; that said ditch is owned by T. J. Tong and E. H. Burnett; that said ditch takes water from said Eight Mile Creek, and its headgate is situate at a point N. 61 degrees and 58 minutes W, 1771, 4 feet from the S. E. corner of Sec. 15, Tp. 18 S, R 69 West; that said ditch is used for the irrigation of fifteen (15) acres of land owned by said Burnett and six (6) acres owned by said Tong; that there be allowed to flow into said ditch, for the irrigation of 8 acres owned by said Burnett and 6 acres owned by said Tong, under and by virtue of said priority No. 353, one cubic foot of water per second of time, for and during such time and times as is sufficient for the irrigation of fourteen (14) acres of land; and that said quantity of water be further allowed to flow into said ditch, under and by virtue of priority No. 391, for the use and benefit of said Burnett, for such additional time and times as is sufficient for the irrigation of seven acres of land.
