

riority No. 354, which is also Cottonwood Creek priority No. 20; that said ditch is owned by Herman King; that the headgate of said ditch is situate on the South side of Cottonwood Creek at a point thereon North 18 degrees and 30 minutes East, 1260 feet, from the quarter corner on the South line of Sec. 23, Tp. 51 N, R. 12 East; and that there be allowed to flow into said ditch, for the use and benefit of the owner thereof, under and by virtue of priority No. 354, one and one half cubic feet of water per second of time, continuously, from April 15th to and until May 1st, of each and every year, or for such less time between said dates, as shall be sufficient to irrigate, once over, twenty (20) acres of land; and that said amount of water be allowed to flow into said ditch for six days in the month of June of each and every year.

No. 362—The Dunham Ditch No. 1.

That said ditch is entitled to Arkansas River priority No. 355, which is also the 1st priority on Spring Creek; that said ditch is owned by Jane Dunham; that the head of said ditch is on the S. E. $\frac{1}{4}$ of the S. W. $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 2, Tp. 19 S, R 70 West; that said ditch is used for the irrigation of five (5) acres of land; and that there be allowed to flow into said ditch for the use of said Dunham, under and by virtue of said priority No. 355, one cubic foot of water per second of time for and during such time and times as is sufficient for the irrigation of said five acres of land.

No. 363—The John Spalding Ditch No. 3.

That said ditch is entitled to Arkansas River priority No. 356, which is also Oak Creek priority No.
