

22; that said ditch is owned by John Spalding; that said ditch takes water from Willow Creek, a tributary of said Oak Creek, and its headgate is situate at a point S. 5 degrees West, 650 feet, from the N. E. corner of the S. E.  $\frac{3}{4}$  of Sec. 20. Tp. 21 S, R 70 West; that said ditch is used for the irrigation of four (4) acres of land; and that there be allowed to flow into said ditch, for the use of said owner, under and by virtue of said priority No. 356, forty-six one hundredths (0.46) of one cubic foot of water per second of time for and during such time and times as is sufficient for the irrigation of said four (4) acres of land.

#### No. 364—The Chavers Ditch.

That said ditch is entitled to Arkansas River priority No. 359, which is also Howard Creek priority No. 15; that said ditch is owned by L. J. Morrison; that the headgate of said ditch is situate on the South Bank of Howard Creek at a point South 88 degrees East, 1393 feet from the quarter section corner between sections 3 and 4, Tp. 48 N, R 10 East; that said ditch is used for the irrigation of six (6) acres of land; and that there be allowed to flow into said ditch, for the use of said owner, under and by virtue of said priority No. 359, one cubic foot of water per second of time for and during such time and times as is sufficient for the irrigation of said six acres of land.

#### No. 365—The Cowan and Webb Ditch.

That said ditch is entitled to Arkansas River priority No. 360, which is also Texas Creek priority No. 99, Brush Creek priority No. 41 and South Brush
