

the irrigation of four (4) acres of land; and that there be allowed to flow into said ditch, for the use of the said owner thereof, under and by virtue of priority No. 368, one half of one cubic foot of water per second of time for and during such time and times as is sufficient for the irrigation of said four (4) acres of land.

No. 371—The Voris Ditch.

That said ditch is entitled to Arkansas River priorities No's 373 and 398, which are also Texas Creek priorities No's 104 and 116, and Lake Creek priorities No's 13 and 15; that said ditch is owned by John D. Voris; that said ditch is used for the irrigation of (55) acres of land; that the headgate of said ditch is situate on the South side of Lake Creek in the N. W. $\frac{1}{4}$ of the S. E. $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 5, Tp. 46 N, R 12 East; that there be allowed to flow into said ditch, for the use of said owner under and by virtue of priority No. 373, one cubic foot of water per second of time, for and during such time and times as is sufficient for the irrigation of thirty-five (35) acres of land; and that there be further allowed to flow into said ditch, for the use of the owner thereof, under and by virtue of priority No. 398, the further quantity of one cubic foot of water per second of time, for and during such time and times as is sufficient for the irrigation of twenty (20) acres of land.

No. 372—The Star Ditch No. 1.

That said ditch is entitled to Arkansas River priority No. 375, which is also Oak Creek priority No. 24; that said ditch is owned by M. U. Stoneburner; that said ditch takes water from said Oak Creek and
