

its headgate is situate on the East side thereof; that said ditch is used for the irrigation of six acres of land; that there be allowed to flow into said ditch, for the use of said owner thereof, under and by virtue of priority No. 375, one cubic foot of water per second of time for and during such time and times as is sufficient for the irrigation of said six acres of land.

#### No. 373—The Star Ditch No. 2.

That said ditch is entitled to Arkansas River priority No. 375, which is also Oak Creek priority No. 24; that said ditch is owned by M. U. Stoneburner; that said ditch takes water from said Oak Creek, and its head is on the West side thereof; that said ditch is used for the irrigation of five (5) acres of land, and that there be allowed to flow into said ditch for the use of the said owner thereof under and by virtue of priority No. 375 one cubic foot of water per second of time for and during such time and times as is sufficient for the irrigation of said five acres of land.

#### No. 374—State Canal No. 1.

As this canal is not yet completed no decree can be made concerning it at this time.

#### No. 375—The West Ditch.

That said ditch is entitled to Arkansas River priority No. 379, which is also West Creek priority No. 5; that said ditch is owned by A. D. Looper; that said ditch takes its water from said West Creek, and its headgate is situate on the South side thereof in the N. W.  $\frac{3}{4}$  of the N. W.  $\frac{1}{4}$  of Sec. 11, Tp. 48 N, R 10
