

East; that said ditch is used for the irrigation of thirty (30) acres of land; and that there be allowed to flow into said ditch, for the use of said owner thereof, under and by virtue of priority No. 379, one cubic foot of water per second of time, for and during such time and times as is sufficient for the irrigation of said thirty acres of land.

No. 376—The Cramlet Ditch.

That said ditch is entitled to Arkansas River priority No. 380, which is also Hamilton Creek priority No. 3; that said ditch is owned by S. W. Piefer; that the head of said ditch is situate at a point in the S. W. $\frac{1}{4}$ of the S. W. $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 30, Tp. 48 R. 11 East; that said ditch is used for the irrigation of thirty-five (35) acres of land; and that there be allowed to flow into said ditch, for the use of the owner thereof, under and by virtue of priority No. 380, one cubic foot of water per second of time for and during such time and times as is sufficient for the irrigation of said thirty-five acres of land.

No. 377—The Stonehenge Reservoir and Canal.

That said reservoir and canal are not yet completed and their rights cannot be herein decreed.

No. 378—The Ewing and Coppe Ditch.

That said ditch is entitled to Arkansas River priority No. 381, which is also Plum Creek, a tributary of said Arkansas River, priority No. 1; that said ditch is owned by Jane M. Brown and Robert Koppe, each of whom owns an undivided one half thereof; that said ditch takes water from said Plum Creek at a point in the N. E. $\frac{1}{4}$ of the S. W. $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 2, Tp.
