

19 S, R 70 West, 1925 feet East and 1395 feet North of the S. W. corner of said section; that said ditch is used for the irrigation of eight (8) acres of land; and that there be allowed to flow into said ditch, for the use and benefit of the owners thereof, under and by virtue of said priority No. 381, one cubic foot of water per second of time, for and during such time and times as is sufficient for the irrigation of said eight acres of land.

No. 379—The Houle Ditch No. 6.

That said ditch is entitled to Arkansas River priority No. 383, which is also Texas Creek priority No. 106, Brush Creek priority No. 44, and North Brush Creek priority No. 11; that said ditch is owned by Elizabeth Houle; that the headgate of said ditch is situate at a point on the West side of said West Brush Creek, 700 feet West of the quarter section corner on the South line of Sec. 14, Tp. 46 N, R 12 East; that said ditch is used for the irrigation of three hundred (300) acres of land; and that there be allowed to flow into said ditch, continuously, for the use and benefit of said owner thereof, under and by virtue of priority No. 383, seven and eighty-nine hundredths (7.89) cubic feet of water per second of time, or such less quantity as is sufficient for the irrigation of said 300 acres of land.

No. 380—The J. M. Parker Ditch.

That said ditch is entitled to Arkansas River priority No. 384, which is also Hayden Creek priority No. 19; that said ditch is owned by J. M. Parker; that said ditch takes water from said Hayden Creek, and its headgate is situate 70 feet West of a point on
