

No. 385—The Short Creek Ditch.

That said ditch is entitled to Arkansas River priorities No's 390 and 396, which are also Texas Creek priorities No's 109 and 115 and Short Creek priorities No's 2 and 3; that said ditch is owned by John D. Voris; that said ditch takes water from said Short Creek and its headgate is situate on the North side of said creek in the S. W. $\frac{1}{4}$ of the S. E. $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 4, Tp. 46 N, R 12 East; that said ditch is used for the irrigation of fifteen (15) acres of land; that there be allowed to flow into said ditch for the use of the said owner thereof, under and by virtue of priority No. 390, one cubic foot of water per second of time for and during such time and times as is sufficient for the irrigation of five (5) acres of land; and that said quantity of water be further allowed to flow into said ditch, under and by virtue of priority No. 396, for such additional time and times as is sufficient for the irrigation of ten (10) acres of land.

No. 386—The Bear Gulch Ditch.

That said ditch is entitled to Arkansas River priority No. 391, which is also Oak Creek priority No. 25, and Bear Gulch priority No. 1; that said ditch takes its water from said Bear Gulch and from springs and its head is on the North side thereof; that said ditch is used for the irrigation of three (3) acres of land; and that there be allowed to flow into said ditch, for the use of said owner thereof, under and by virtue of priority No. 391 one half of one cubic foot of water per second of time and for and during such time and times as is sufficient for the irrigation of said three acres of land; that said ditch is owned and possessed by J. M. Woodruff.
