

by James Walker; that said ditch takes water from said South Brush Creek at a point on the South East side thereof, in S. W. $\frac{1}{4}$ of the N. E. $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 27, Tp. 46 N, R 12 East; that said ditch is used for the irrigation of fifty-two (52) acres of land; that there be allowed to flow into said ditch, for the use of said owner, under and by virtue of priority No. 393, constantly, one and three hundred and sixty-eight (1,368) thousandths cubic feet of water per second of time.

No. 389—Stonehenge Seepage Ditch.

That this ditch has made no appropriation of water, as yet.

No. 390—The L. J. Dawson and J. C. Erickson Ditch.

That said ditch is entitled to Arkansas River priority No. 405, which is also Texas Creek priority No. 117; that said ditch is owned by L. J. Dawson and J. C. Erickson, each of whom owns an undivided one half thereof; that the headgate of said ditch is situate at a point whence the North West corner of Tp. 22, S, R 73 West, bears N. 71 degrees West, 1250 feet; that said ditch is used for the irrigation of one hundred and sixty (160) acres of land owned by said Erickson; and that there be allowed to flow into said ditch, constantly, under priority No. 405, four and twenty-one hundredths (4.21) cubic feet of water per second of time.

No. 391—The Durfee Extension of Bridge No. 3 Ditch.

That said ditch has not yet appropriated water.
