

No. 392—The Jones and Parker Ditch.

That said ditch has not yet appropriated water.

No. 393—The West Ditch Extension.

That said ditch has not yet appropriated water.

No. 394—The Echo Ditch.

That said ditch is entitled to Arkansas River priority No. 408, which is also Sand Creek priority No. 1; that said ditch is owned by George W. Doyle; that said ditch takes its water from Cottonwood Gulch and from springs therein; and its head is situate at a point 650 feet East and 250 feet North from the S. W. corner of the S. E. $\frac{1}{4}$ of the S. W. $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 18, Tp. 19 S, R 70 West; that the testimony does not disclose how much land has been irrigated by said ditch and its rights cannot, therefore, be determined at this time.

No. 395—The Cottonwood Pipe-line Ditch.

That said ditch is entitled to Arkansas River priority No. 409, which is also Sand Creek priority No. 2; but that said priority shall not be subject in any way to priority No. 1 on Green Gulch, hereby decreed to the Green Gulch Pipe Line and Ditch, but this ditch shall be entitled to such water as it may be able to obtain out of said Green Gulch at the point where its headgate is located, and from the springs from which claimant Doyle now takes water; that said ditch is owned by George W. Doyle; that said ditch takes its water from springs in Cottonwood Gulch, a tributary of Sand Creek; that the evidence does not
