Review Travel Trailer Ordinance 11-7A

Matt Richardson opened the meeting by explaining information for a new ordinance that will remove the enforcement section A of 11-7A-1 of the Akron Municipal Code. The Council then began to discuss other concerns of the Travel Trailer Parks code in terms of the service building and other requirements of the code. Lengthy discussion was held and Council was able to ask Matt to update some parts of the code for review at the next meeting.

Trailer Parking on Residential Streets

Council had another lengthy discussion about the many reasons why trailers could be parked on the residential streets of Akron and also the variety of trailers to be parked. Current code does not allow for trailer parking in residential areas of Akron. There may be certain circumstances where it could be allowed for a short period of time. Council asked Matt to review and rewrite an ordinance that would update trailer parking in Akron.

Attorney Report

Matt Richardson reported that since the last meeting he had been in touch with Marjorie Brandon's attorneys and they said that a check should be released and received within the next week along with a receipt and release.
