**RESOLUTION 2014-13**

**A RESOLUTION DECLARING THE TOWN OF SILVERTON WILL CONDUCT A SPECIAL  
RECALL ELECTION ON FEBRUARY 10, 2015, WITH SUCH ELECTION  
TO BE CONDUCTED BY MAIL-BALLOT.**

**WHEREAS**, the Town Board certified a recall election petition on December 8, 2014, which requires a special recall election to be held; and

**WHEREAS**, on December 15, 2014, the Town Board set the election date for the special election to be January 27, 2015, and determined that the election will be a mail-ballot election; and

**WHEREAS**, the San Juan County Clerk and Recorder will serve as an Election Official for this special election and will work with the Interim Town Clerk to complete the special election in accordance with all State regulations and laws; and

**WHEREAS**, Town and County staff have reviewed all statutory requirements and deemed that the election date should be changed to February 10, 2015, in order to ensure all election requirements are satisfactorily met.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF SILVERTON,  
COLORADO, THAT:**

- 1) The Town of Silverton will conduct the special election on February 10, 2015, by mail-ballot in accordance with Title 31 of the Colorado Revised Statutes (CRS).
- 2) The Town of Silverton Interim Town Clerk will certify all eligible candidate petitions submitted by December 26, 2014, and will prepare the final ballot.
- 3) The San Juan County Clerk and Recorder will assist with voter registration and election questions, mail ballot to registered voters, count all ballots, and execute the election in accordance with Title, 31, Article 10, CRS.
- 4) The San Juan County Clerk and Recorders office located in the San Juan County Courthouse at 1557 Greene Street, Silverton, Colorado, will be the designated Voter Service and Polling Center.
