**A RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE RECOMMENDATIONS OF THE DOWNTOWN
COLORADO INC. (DCI) REPORT**

WHEREAS, the Town Board of Trustees has identified downtown enhancement as a high priority for the economic well being of the community; and

WHEREAS, the Town Board of Trustees recognizes the "Downtown" primarily as an area encompassing Greene and Blair (Empire) Streets from 10th to 14th Streets, but also including side streets and other areas of the B-P (Business-Pedestrian) Zone; and

WHEREAS, The Town contracted with Downtown Colorado, Inc. to assess the viability and potential of our core business district by bringing together a volunteer team of professionals, community leaders and stakeholders; and.

WHEREAS, the Town Board of Trustees has the authority to set priorities for capital improvement projects aimed at revitalizing the Downtown area; and

WHEREAS, The DCI final report outlines a detailed description of their findings and recommendations which the Board of Trustees finds useful and desires to begin a program of implementation;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF SILVERTON, COLORADO THAT:

The DCI report shall serve as the guiding document in the Town's efforts to revitalize and improve its Downtown area. Through this adoption, the Board maintains that it may except, or accept, individual recommendations of the Report and may elect to add, delete, modify or expand upon the recommendations therein to the extent that changing conditions or new observations may so warrant.
