**RESOLUTION NO. 2013-05**

**ESTABLISHING CERTAIN EXEMPTIONS TO ADOPTED EMERGENCY SNOW  
ROUTE PROVISIONS**

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Trustees of the Town of Silverton, through its adoption of Resolution 2012-17, implemented uniform snow route procedures throughout all Town streets and alleys; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Trustees is now desirous of further revision to the uniform procedures established via Resolution 2012-17 for the benefit of the public safety and welfare;

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE  
TOWN OF SILVERTON THAT:**

- 1) Resolution 2012-17 - adopted by the Town of Silverton Board of Trustees on November 26, 2012 - is hereby repealed and replaced in its entirety with the provisions established herein.
- 2) All Town streets and alleys are hereby established as formal snow routes and the restrictions herein established shall be uniformly applied as to all Town streets, alleys and other public right-of-ways subject to the limited explicit exemptions established in this Resolution
- 3) The Town shall establish and maintain an official snow route hotline, which shall advise motorists of the limitations imposed on lawful parking during periods of red snow route alerts. This number shall be conspicuously posted at each entrance to Town, and by 5:00 pm the evening of an anticipated alert, shall provide callers with specific information as to the nature of the parking restrictions herein established. Parking restrictions during a periods of red alert shall be imposed as follows:
  - a. During red alert periods, there shall be no parking whatsoever in any Town alley such that the parked vehicle has the potential to impede snow removal operations in such alley
  - b. On even days of the month, vehicles shall be parked on the even addressed side of the street by 12:01 am and shall remain there until snow removal operations on the opposing, *odd*, side of the street have been completed by the Town Public Works Department
  - c. On odd days of the month, vehicles shall be parked on the odd addressed side of the street by 12:01 am and shall remain there until snow removal operations on the opposing, *even*, side of the street have been completed by the Town Public Works Department.
  - d. After snow removal operations are complete on the restricted side of a street, vehicles must then be moved to the opposing side of the street as soon as possible after snow has been adequately cleared therefrom.

- c. Subsections (a) and (b) above shall not apply to River Street parking. Vehicles shall remain parked on the west side of River street during a snow alert regardless of whether the alert falls on an odd or even day and such vehicles shall be moved to the east side of the street after such time as the Town Public Works Department has adequately removed snow from the east side of River Street to allow parking there.
  - f. Subsections (a) and (b) above shall not apply to 12<sup>th</sup> and 14<sup>th</sup> Streets between Greene and Reese Streets between the hours of 12:01 am and 9:00 am. During a red snow alert, vehicles shall be permitted to park on either side of these blocks of 12<sup>th</sup> and 14<sup>th</sup> Streets, but only to the extent that they have a clearly visible and dated Town-approved permit displayed on their dash boards issued by a local lodging business. By 9:01 am on snow alert days, all vehicles parked on this block should be moved to Greene Street or may be subject to violation.
  - g. From 12:01 am until 9:00 am during red alert periods, there shall be **no parking whatsoever** on the entirety of **Greene Street**. If a red alert has been declared, cars shall be removed to the side streets in accordance to with the general restrictions established in sections (a), (b) and (c) above.
  - h. From 12:01 am until 11:00 am, during red alert periods, there shall be **no parking whatsoever** on **Blair Street** from 10<sup>th</sup> Street to 14<sup>th</sup> Street. If a red alert has been declared, cars shall be removed to the side streets in accordance to with the general restrictions established in sections (a), (b) and (c) above. This subsection 3(h) shall expire on January 31, 2014, after which time restrictions on Blair Street from 10<sup>th</sup> to 14<sup>th</sup> Street shall revert to those established in subsections (b), (c), and (d) above.
4. Pursuant to Ordinance 2010-02, the Sheriff's Department may issue a ticket and fine of not less than \$25 to the owner of any vehicle found in of the routes established herein.
  5. Vehicles in violation of these snow routes may be subject to tow and impoundment by the Town and/or its authorized agent at the owners' expense.
