



## Resolution 2019-05

### A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF SILVERTON, COLORADO, AMENDING ORDINANCE 2017-05 BY ADOPTING A TEMPORARY MODIFICATION OF THE OHV ROUTE DURING THE FOURTH OF JULY HOLIDAY

WHEREAS, registered electors of the Town of Silverton have petitioned the Board of Trustees for the Board of Trustees to expand as needed rights-of-way for use by Off-Highway Vehicles (OHVs), All-Terrain Vehicles (ATVs), and Unlicensed Vehicles;

WHEREAS, on April 28, 2014, the Board passed Ordinance 2014-01 establishing permanent access to OHV, ATV, and Unlicensed Vehicles along specified routes;

WHEREAS, pursuant to C.R.S §33-14.5-101, *et seq.* the Board has amended Ordinance 2014-01 and codified the regulation of OHVs and ATVs in Article 3 of Chapter 9 of the Silverton Municipal Code;

WHEREAS, pursuant to C.R.S. §42-4-110(B), the Town of Silverton maintains the authority to enact and enforce traffic regulations on all town rights of way within its jurisdiction;

WHEREAS, the Town Board of Trustees has recognized the need to mitigate a high volume of OHV traffic for campers over the Fourth of July, and desires to provide a direct route for OHVs to access temporarily established campgrounds during the holiday, identified as July 1st through midnight July 7<sup>th</sup> 2019;


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY BE RESOLVED BY THE TOWN BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF SILVERTON COLORADO THAT the Town of Silverton Board of Trustees Approves and Adopts a Temporary Modification of the OHV Route as identified in Exhibit A to include:


- Extension of the OHV route down 14<sup>th</sup> Street into the Kendall Mountain Recreation Area Parking Lot

The modification of the OHV Route as identified herein shall be effective on July 1, 2019 and shall automatically terminate at midnight on July 7, 2019.

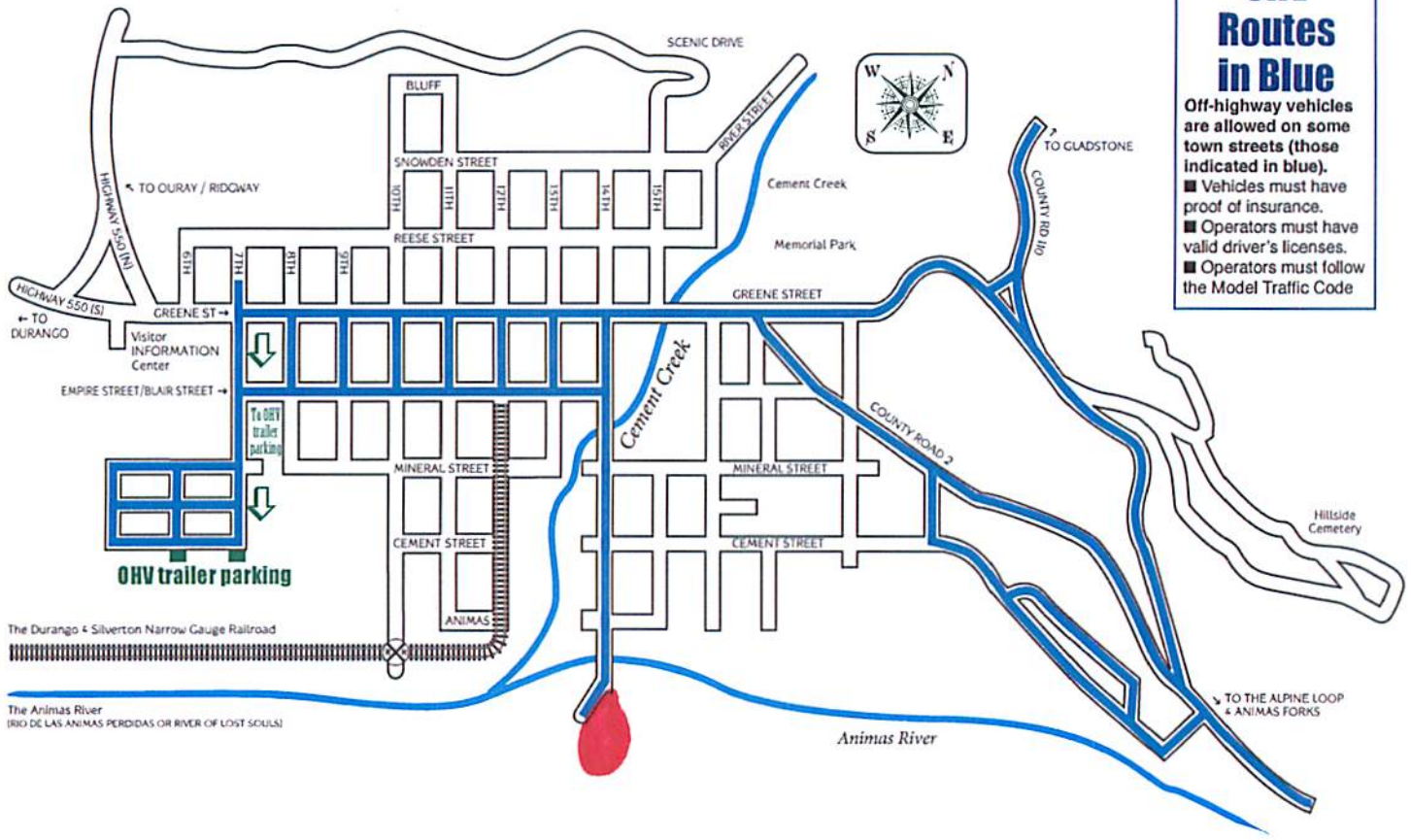
