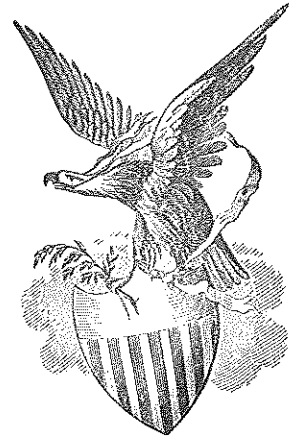

## TOWN OF SILVERTON, COLORADO

### ORDINANCE NO. 2009- 02

AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF SILVERTON, COLORADO, AMENDING SECTIONS 6-9-5, 6-9-6, AND 6-9-7 FOR THE PURPOSE OF SETTING FINES AND ALLOWING FOR TOWING OF VEHICLES IN VIOLATION OF ESTABLISHED SNOW ROUTES SET BY POLICY OF THE TOWN BOARD.

Whereas, the Board of Trustees finds a case of special emergency such that delaying passage of this ordinance would result in decreased provision of services and a decrease in the orderly conduct of Town business;

Whereas, the Town Board finds that sections 6-9-5, 6-9-6, AND 6-9-7 do not provide adequate authority for the enforcement of snow routes established by the Town of Silverton;

Whereas, the Town Board finds that full enforcement of established snow routes is necessary for the preservation of the public health, safety, and general welfare; and

Whereas, the Town Board finds that full enforcement of established snow routes will allow for more efficient and timely plowing of public streets, alleys, and other rights-of-way;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF SILVERTON THAT:

A. Section 6-9-5 of the Code of the Town of Silverton shall be revised to read as follows:

MANDATORY COMPLIANCE WITH ESTABLISHED SNOW ROUTES & REMOVAL OF PARKED VEHICLES: It shall be unlawful within the corporate limits of the Town of Silverton for any person to park in violation of an established snow route, or to park in any manner that obstructs the removal of snow from the public streets and alleys. Any vehicle in violation of this section may be ticketed and/or towed from that location by the Town or an agent of the Town, and all costs incurred for the towing and


storage of the vehicle in violation will be assessed to the owner of the vehicle. Said costs shall not be construed to be in lieu of any fines levied by the municipal court. The fine for violating this section shall be \$150.00.


- B. Section 6-9-6 of the Code of the Town of Silverton shall be revised to read as follows:

ADEQUATE NOTICE: of 6-9-5 shall be given by posting signs on Greene Street at both entrances to Town with snow route information.

- C. Section 6-9-7 of the Code of the Town of Silverton shall be stricken as it is no longer necessary.
- D. Snow routes shall be established by resolution of the Town Board, and shall be in full force and effect. Such resolution shall also provide instructions for complying with established snow routes.
- E. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect five days following its publication in the newspaper.
