



ORDINANCE NO. 2015 – 03

**AN ORDINANCE MODIFYING ARTICLE 2 OF CHAPTER 13 OF THE TOWN CODE
DETAILING THE USE OF OHV's, ATV's, AND UNLICENSED VEHICLES ALONG
SPECIFIED ROUTES.**

WHEREAS, the Town Board of Trustees passed Ordinance 2013-02 which adopted the 2010 Model Traffic Code and included modification of certain sections of the code to meet specific requirements; and

WHEREAS, the electorate of the Town of Silverton voted in a biennial election in April of 2014 on a referred measure to allow the use of OHV's on specified routes; and

WHEREAS, following the election the Town Board of Trustees passed Ordinance 2014-01 acknowledging the specified OHV Route Map and Operation requirements for OHV's; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to C.R.S. Section 42-4-110(b), the Town of Silverton (Town) maintains the authority to enact and enforce traffic regulations on roads and streets within its jurisdiction; and

WHEREAS, the Town seeks to modify the approved OHV Route Map and expand allowable use to certain streets within the corporate boundaries.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF SILVERTON, COLORADO that:

Section 1. Findings and Intent. The foregoing recitals are incorporated herein by reference and adopted as findings and determinations of the Town Board.


Section 2. Modification of the Municipal Code. This ordinance modifies Section 2 of Article 2 of Chapter 13 as follows:

13-2-2 Designated Off-Highway Vehicle Routes: In accordance with C.R.S. 33-14.5-108(1), the Town roads as specifically designated on the Town of Silverton – OHV Routes Map, attached hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated herein, are hereby designated as year-round off-highway vehicle routes.

INTRODUCED, APPROVED ON FIRST READING AND ORDERED PUBLISHED ONCE IN FULL on this 4th day of May, 2015.

INTRODUCED AND ADOPTED ON SECOND READING on this 8th day of June, 2015.

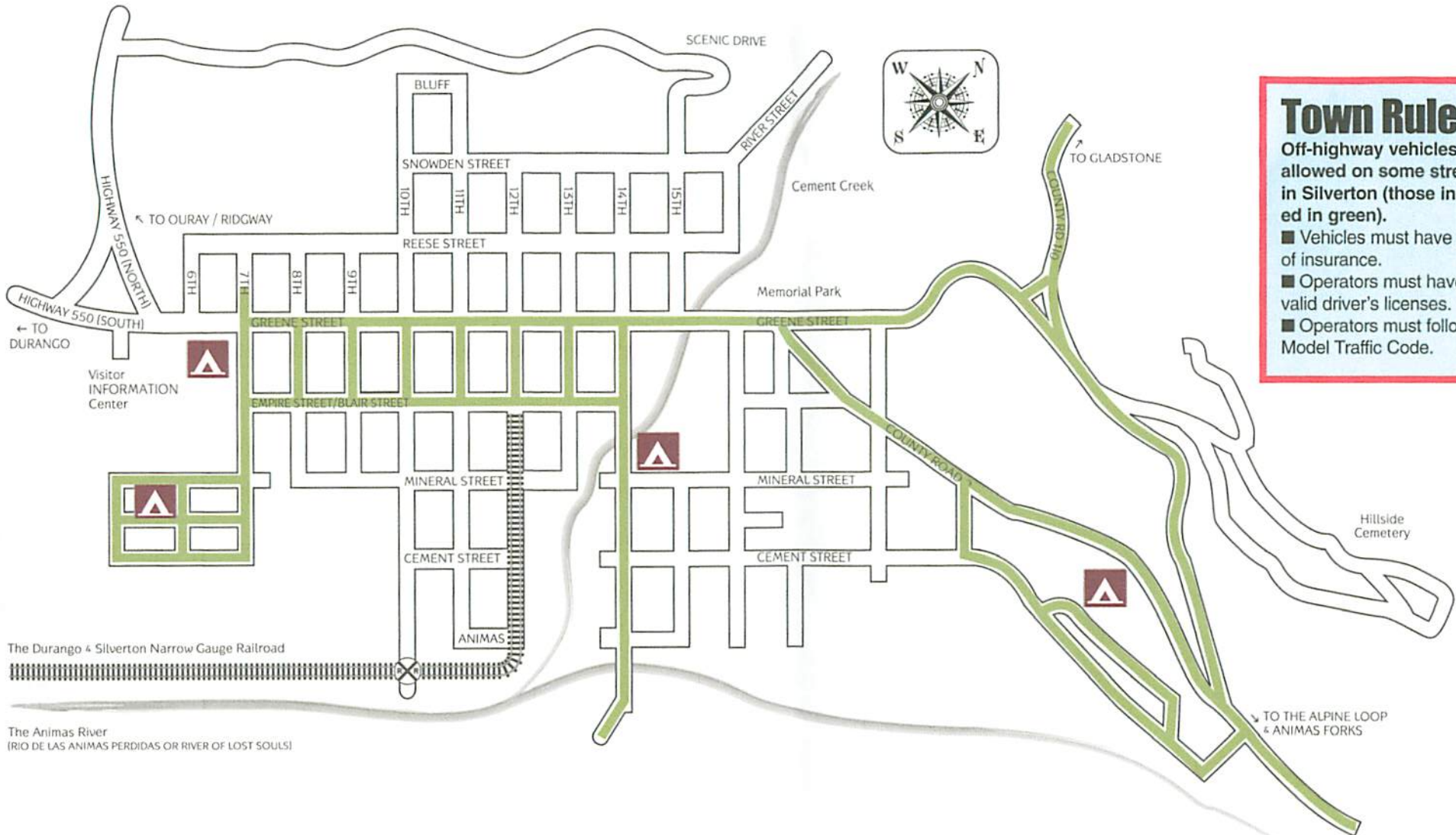
