RESOLUTION 2015-02

A RESOLUTION DECLARING THAT THE TOWN OF SILVERTON WILL CONDUCT A SPECIAL ELECTION ON JANUARY 27, 2015, WITH SUCH ELECTION TO BE CONDUCTED BY MAIL-BALLOT.

WHEREAS, the Town Board certified a recall election petition on December 8, 2014, which requires a special election to be held; and

WHEREAS, the Town Board set the election date for the special election on December 15, 2014, and determined that the election will be a mail-ballot election; and

WHEREAS, the San Juan County Clerk has agreed to serve as the election official for this special election due to the vacancy of the Town Clerks position.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF SILVERTON, COLORADO, THAT:

- 1) The Town of Silverton will conduct the special election on January 27, 2015, by mail-ballot.
- 2) The San Juan County Clerk shall act as the Election Official for the Town and will utilize all resources necessary to conduct the mail-ballot election.
- 3) The mail-ballot plan attached hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated herein by this reference is hereby approved.
