

**RESOLUTION NO. 2003-12**

A RESOLUTION TO AMEND CERTAIN BUSINESS LICENSE, UTILITY, AND SKI LIFT FEES AND TAXES.

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees for the Town of Silverton, Colorado has the authority to set the fees and taxes for businesses and services;

WHEREAS, the Board has determined that current fees and taxes assessed for various businesses and services are not sufficient to cover the costs of providing certain services to the community; and

WHEREAS, the Board has reviewed these fees and taxes in each specific case and has determined that these fees and taxes are fair and equitable and necessary to the provision of services within the community;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees for the Town of Silverton, Colorado that the following fees and taxes for the provision of certain services in the community are hereby adopted as follows:

1. The Clerk-Treasurer is directed to assess and collect for refuse service in accordance with the provisions of Section I-2.7 Sanitation Service Charges, TOWN OF SILVERTON PUBLIC IMPROVEMENT DEVELOPMENT STANDARDS AND SPECIFICATIONS, at the minimum rate of fifty-seven and no/100s dollars per EQR. In conjunction with this adjustment, the Clerk-Treasurer is directed to modify the Senior Citizen Discount for water, sewer, and refuse user charges to eighteen percent (18%).

These rate changes shall become effective January 1, 2004.

2. The Clerk-Treasurer is directed to assess and collect from all businesses, including temporary and home occupation businesses, an occupational tax pursuant to Section 3-2-3 of the Town Code for the Town of Silverton, Colorado in accordance with the following schedule:

One to four employees, inclusive	\$14.00 per day or \$175.00 per annum
Five to nine employees, inclusive	\$15.60 per day or \$195.00 per annum
Ten or more employees	\$18.40 per day or \$230.00 per annum

These rate changes shall become effective January 1, 2004.

3. The Clerk-Treasurer is directed to assess and collect for water tap fees in accordance with the following schedule:

¾" Tap and Service Line	\$2500.00
1" Tap and Service Line	\$2575.00
1 ¼" Tap and Service Line	\$2600.00
1 ½" Tap and Service Line	\$2650.00
2" Tap and Service Line	\$2800.00

For tap and service lines exceeding 2 inches, the fee shall be \$2800.00 plus additional costs, as determined by the Public Works Director, which are directly associated with the larger water service.

For any water tap and service line work requiring additional materials (i.e. asphalt, concrete, flow fill, excessive distance from water main, etc.) or other circumstance effecting additional cost to the Town to install said tap and/or service line, such additional costs shall be

determined by the Public Works Director and charged in addition to the costs specified above.

These rate changes shall become effective upon adoption of this resolution.

4. The Clerk-Treasurer is directed to assess and collect a \$2500.00 tap fee for a 4 inch sewer service line. For any sewer tap and service line work requiring additional materials (i.e. larger sewer line, asphalt, concrete, flow fill, excessive distance from sewer main, etc.) or other circumstance effecting additional cost to the Town to install said tap and/or service line, such additional costs shall be determined by the Public Works Director and charged in addition to the \$2500.00 base fee.

These rate changes shall become effective upon adoption of this resolution.

5. The Clerk-Treasurer is directed to assess and collect a \$900.00 per EQR water plant investment fee and a \$900.00 per EQR sewer plant investment fee, as is appropriate, for all new water and/or sewer services when the properties being connected to the utility system(s) have not been paying regular service charges.

These rate changes shall become effective upon adoption of this resolution.


6. The Clerk-Treasurer is directed to charge and collect for ski lift ticket prices in accordance with the following schedule:


Adults (19-64)	
Day Pass	\$ 7.00/day
Seasonal Pass	\$ 60.00/season
Children (6-18)	
Day Pass	\$ 4.00/day
Seasonal Pass	\$ 40.00/season
Seniors (65+)	
Day Pass	\$ 4.00/day
Seasonal Pass	\$ 40.00/season
Family Season Pass (2 Adults & 2 Children)	\$140.00/season
Additional Children	\$10.00/child/season

These rate changes shall become effective upon the adoption of this resolution.
