

RESOLUTION NO. 2006-16

A RESOLUTION TO AMEND CERTAIN UTILITY AND BUSINESS LICENSE FEES:

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees for the Town of Silverton, Colorado has the authority to set the fees and taxes for businesses and services;

WHEREAS, the Board has determined that current fees and taxes assessed for various services are not sufficient to cover the costs of providing certain services to residents and visitors to the community;

WHEREAS, the Board has reviewed these fees and taxes in each specific case and has determined that these fees and taxes are fair and equitable and necessary to the provision of services within the community;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees for the Town of Silverton, Colorado that the following fees for the provision of certain services in the community are hereby adopted as follows:


1. Effective January 1, 2007, the Clerk-Treasurer is directed to charge for water service in accordance with the provisions of Section I-2.2 Water and Sewer Service Charges, TOWN OF SILVERTON PUBLIC IMPROVEMENT DEVELOPMENT STANDARDS AND SPECIFICATIONS, at the following rates:
  - a. One (1) EQR shall be charged at the minimum rate of eighty three and 16/100 dollars (\$83.16) per quarter; and
  - b. Water use for all customers billed on a metered rate shall be charged a minimum fee of \$83.16 for the first 25,000 gallons used, or fraction thereof, plus two and 73/100 (\$2.73) dollars per 1,000 gallons, or fraction thereof, in excess of 25,000 gallons per quarter.
2. Effective January 1, 2007, the Clerk-Treasurer is directed to charge for sewer service in accordance with the provisions of Section I-2.2 Water and Sewer Service Charges, TOWN OF SILVERTON PUBLIC IMPROVEMENT DEVELOPMENT STANDARDS AND SPECIFICATIONS, at the following rates:
  - a. One (1) EQR shall be charged at the minimum rate of eighty seven and 00/100 dollars (\$87.00) per quarter; and
  - b. Sewer use for all customers billed on a metered rate shall be charged a minimum fee of \$87.00 for the first 25,000 gallons used, or fraction thereof, plus three and 36/100 (\$3.36) dollars per 1,000 gallons, or fraction thereof, in excess of 25,000 gallons per quarter.
3. Effective January 1, 2007, the Clerk-Treasurer is directed to charge for sanitation service in accordance with the provisions of Section I-2.7 Sanitation Service Charges (Landfill), TOWN OF SILVERTON PUBLIC IMPROVEMENT DEVELOPMENT STANDARDS AND SPECIFICATIONS, at the following rates:


- a. One (1) EQR shall be charged at the minimum rate of fifty two and 00/100 dollars (\$52.00) per quarter; and
  - b. Section I-2.7(E.) Non-full-year or seasonally occupied properties, TOWN OF SILVERTON PUBLIC IMPROVEMENT DEVELOPMENT STANDARDS AND SPECIFICATIONS, is hereby removed from said standards and specifications. The purpose of removing this section is to eliminate sanitation fee exemptions for non-full-year or seasonally occupied properties and ensure all Town of Silverton utility customers will be charged an appropriate sanitation fee, pursuant to Section I-2.7 Sanitation Service Charges (Landfill), TOWN OF SILVERTON PUBLIC IMPROVEMENT DEVELOPMENT STANDARDS AND SPECIFICATIONS.
4. Effective January 1, 2007, the Clerk-Treasurer is directed to assess and collect from all businesses, including special event vendors, a business license fee pursuant to Section 10-4-8 of the Town Code for the Town of Silverton, Colorado in accordance with the following schedule:

One to four (1-4) employees, inclusive:	\$125.00 per annum
Five to nine (5-9) employees, inclusive:	\$150.00 per annum
Ten or more (10+) employees:	\$175.00 per annum
Special Event Vendor permits	\$20.00 per day
