

RESOLUTION 79-2019

WHEREAS, by prior action on May 6, 2019 the Board of County Commissioners appointed Misty Whitt as County Administrator; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners can prescribe the duties to be performed by such appointees per C.R.S. 30-11-107 (1) (n); and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners can establish policies and procedures regarding entering into contracts per C.R.S. 30-11-107 (1) (aa).

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF WASHINGTON COUNTY, as follows:

1. The duties of the County Administrator will now include the ability to establish policies and procedures regarding entering into contracts binding on the county.
2. The duties of the County Administrator will now include the ability to perform evaluations for all Department Heads on behalf of the Board of County Commissioners. This change will supersede the wording in all existing Employee Agreements.

The Clerk to the Board is hereby directed to incorporate this change into the annual reorganization Resolution and it will be included in all individual Employment Agreements.

The foregoing Resolution was presented at a regular meeting of the Washington County Commissioners held on the 22nd day of October 2019 by Commissioner Wells who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Willeke and on roll call vote, all votes being yes, the resolution was adopted.
