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Did You Know?

When submitting claims on the Provider Web Portal, a maximum of 5 MB is allowed for "Attachments" under "File Transfer." If an attachment larger than 5 MB is uploaded, the user will receive an error message after submitting the claim.

All Providers

Reminder to Update Contact Information for Member Search

Member search tools, including the provider directory, have improved the accuracy of information provided to members, which makes it more important for providers to keep their contact information updated via the Provider WebPortal. Updates made via the Web Portal will usually be reflected on the Department's website in 48 hours and on the PEAKHealth mobile app in 10-14 days.

Health First Colorado (Colorado's Medicaid Program) and Child Health Plan *Plus* (CHP+) members have multiple ways to find a provider via the Find a Doctor tools found on the <u>Department of Health Care Policy & Financing (the Department's) website</u>, the <u>Health First Colorado website</u> and the <u>PEAKHealth mobile app</u>. The data in these heavily-used search tools includes provider contact information, demographics, services offered and open panel status.

Incorrect data in the provider search can be corrected by performing a data maintenance update in the provider profile area of the Provider Web Portal. For more details on updating information, refer to the Provider Maintenance Provider Web Portal Quick Guide, located on the Quick Guides web page.

Upcoming Colorado interChange Update - ClaimsXten™ Claims Editing Solution

The Colorado interChange is being updated with a claims editing solution in accordance with <u>Senate Bill (SB)</u> <u>18-266</u>, which requires the Department to implement new initiatives intended to help control Health First Colorado's costs and ensure appropriate claims payment. The Department and DXC Technology (DXC) are working with Change Healthcare to implement the ClaimsXten™ tool.

Professional and Outpatient claims received in Colorado interChange will automatically process through $ClaimsXten^{m}$ to apply additional editing based on State and Federal policies. This additional editing tool will help to identify inappropriate bill coding and reduce potential overpayments.

Hospitals

The <u>Ensuring Appropriate Claims Payment project</u> is anticipated to begin in late Fall 2020. The project has two components:

- Implementing the new ClaimsXten™ tool
- Improving the existing 3M Enhanced Ambulatory Patient Grouping (EAPG) solution to improve payment accuracy

An informational webinar will be available prior to the system change. All providers are encouraged to attend the webinar for information regarding ClaimsXten $^{\text{m}}$ and the upcoming improvements to the 3M EAPG solution.

Provider training sessions will also be announced soon. These sessions will be conducted by DXC and will provide technical guidance.

As of June 29, 2020, the updated rates have been posted, alongside appeal rights, to the <u>Inpatient Hospital Payment web page</u> for their 30-day review. The implementation of these rates is pending approval from the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) with a mass adjustment to follow.

Per Diem Rate Update

The State Fiscal Year 2020-21 Long Bill (<u>HB20-1360</u>) was signed by Governor Polis on June 22, 2020, which approved a 1% rate decrease to per diem payment rates. As of July 17, 2020, the updated rates have been posted for rehabilitation, long-term acute care, spine/brain injury treatment and mental health hospitals, alongside appeal rights, to the <u>Inpatient Hospital Per Diem Reimbursement Group web page</u> for their 30-day review. The implementation of these rates is pending approval from CMS, with a mass adjustment to follow.

Hospital-Based Rural Health Clinics (RHCs)

RHC Reconciliations

Due to COVID-19, the hospital-based RHC reconciliation takebacks for calendar year 2015 and 2016 rates were postponed. The Department will be performing these reconciliations in the near future. Impacted providers will be contacted before these reconciliations are processed.

This only impacts hospital-based RHCs whose 2015 or 2016 final audited rate was lower than their interim rate.

Replacement of Current Procedural Terminology (CPT) Codes with Healthcare Common Procedure Coding System (HCPCS) Codes

Effective August 1, 2020, the Department will begin reviewing the public comments received regarding the closing of CPT codes 80320-80377 and the opening of HCPCS codes G0480-G0483.

Providers are reminded to continue using CPT codes 80320-80377 until further notice. Updates will be provided via future provider bulletins.

Nursing Facilities

Nursing Facility Fiscal Year 2020-2021 Rate Updates

Nursing Facility rates have been finalized effective July 1, 2020 - June 30, 2021. All facility rates have been loaded in the Colorado interChange and reimbursement should reflect updated rates for all claims billed for dates of service on or after July 1, 2020.

Hospice providers billing for Revenue Code 0659 are impacted by the Nursing Facility rate updates. The rates have been implemented and reimbursement for services should reflect the updated rates for all claims billed for dates of service on or after July 1, 2020.

The Skilled Nursing Facility and Hospice Room and Board fee schedule, effective July 1, 2020 - June 30, 2021, has been posted on the <u>Provider Rates and Fee Schedule web page</u> under the Skilled Nursing Facility drop-down section. The fee schedule includes:

- Skilled Nursing Facility (SNF) National Provider Identifier (NPI) ID
- Skilled Nursing Facility (SNF) Name
- SNF Rate
- Hospice Room and Board (R&B) Rate
- Rate Begin and End Dates

Outpatient, Physical and Occupational Therapy <u>Providers</u>

48-Unit Benefit Limit in Provider Web Portal

Providers are reminded that members may receive up to 48 units of any combination of physical therapy/occupational therapy (PT/OT) services per rolling 12-month period before a Prior Authorization Request (PAR) is required. Evaluation and orthotic services are not included in this limit. This equates to



roughly 12 hours of therapy services (each unit of service being equal to 15 minutes). This unit limit will be automatically enforced by the Colorado interChange by denying claims that exceed the limit.

The Provider Web Portal will display the number of outpatient PT/OT units a member has used in the past 12 months; however, the accuracy of the Web Portal is limited by the timeliness of submitted claims. It should not be relied upon to inform the provider of an

absolute number of remaining units. Providers are advised to always seek a PAR at the beginning of a member's therapy if it is anticipated the member will require more than 48 units of service in a 12-month period.

Beginning September 1, 2020, providers will not be granted a retroactive PAR based on the unit count displayed in the Provider Web Portal.

Pharmacy Providers

Pharmacist-Administered Flu Vaccine for the 2020-2021 Flu Season

Beginning in mid-August of 2020, Health First Colorado members aged 19 years and over will be eligible to receive influenza vaccinations by an enrolled pharmacist at a Health First Colorado-enrolled pharmacy. Claims must be billed through the medical benefit.



Staff who submit claims, are new to billing Health First Colorado services, or need a billing refresher course should consider attending one or more of the following provider training sessions.
