## Table 1: Allowable Provider Type by ASAM Level

If the service is provided by a **<u>CCBHC</u>**:

- Costs are considered direct CCBHC expenses for the cost report as specified the CCBHC Cost Report Instructions<sup>ii</sup>
- Visits are included on the daily visit tab as specified in content section 9 of the CCBHC Cost Report Instructions

If the service is provided by a **DCO**:

- **Costs** are considered under agreement with DCO and included in Part 1B of the cost report
- Visits are included on the daily visit tab as specified in content section 9 of the CCBHC Cost Report Instructions

If the service is provided through a **referral**:

- Service costs are not included on the cost report
- Service visits are not included on the cost report
- Allowable care coordination costs are included on the cost report<sup>iii</sup>
- Care coordination is regarded as an activity rather than a service. Visits for care coordination services only are not included on the cost report<sup>iv</sup>
- See CCBHC Program Requirement 3 for further guidance concerning care coordination
