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Purpose:

This letter is meant to advise counties and eligibility sites of the 2018 Social Security Cost of Living Adjustments (COLA). Please share this agency letter with all affected Adult and Long-Term Care Medicaid eligibility staff, supervisors, and outside agencies, as appropriate.

Background:

Monthly Social Security and Supplemental Security Income benefits will increase due to a COLA of 2% in 2018. The purpose of the COLA is to ensure that the purchasing power of Social Security and Supplemental Security Income (SSI) benefits is not eroded by inflation. It is based on the percentage increase in the Consumer Price Index for Urban Wage Earners and Clerical Workers from the third quarter of the last year a COLA was determined to the third quarter of the current year.

The 300% income limit, home equity maximum, minimum monthly maintenance needs allowance maximum and the community spouse resource allowance will increase. The Medicare Part B premium will also increase.

Beginning January 1, 2018, the Medicare Nursing Facility Co-Insurance Rate and the Income Trust Gross Income Limits and Average Nursing Facility Private Pay Rates will change. Additionally, the Personal Needs Allowance (PNA) base amount for residents of

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Nursing and Intermediate Care Facilities will increase by 3%, setting the 2018 PNA Base Amount at \$84.41.
