The purpose of this Informational Memo is to inform Case Management Agencies (CMA), Community Centered Boards (CCB), Individuals with Intellectual and Developmental Disabilities (I/DD) and their families and advocates of clarification on Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ) regarding Developmental Disability and Delay Determinations for individuals with co-occurring I/DD or Neurological conditions and Mental Health.

Information:

The process for completing a Developmental Disability or Delay Determination can be complex when the individual being determined has multiple co-occurring diagnoses of I/DD, Mental Health and/or other Neurological conditions. The Department of Health Care Policy & Financing (Department) has identified a need to provide clarification on the determination process when such instances occur. The attached FAQ document addresses common questions that the community and CCBs have with regards to completing a determination for these individuals. CCBs can use this document for
