Purpose and Audience:

The purpose of this Operational Memo is to provide instructions for Home Care Agencies required to notify employees of compensation increases and minimum wage per Colorado Revised Statute number 25.5-6-1601 et seq., C.R.S. (2019).

Information:

The Colorado Department of Health Care Policy and Financing (HCPF), in collaboration with the Training Advisory Committee, has developed the <u>Compensation Increase for</u> <u>Home Care Professionals</u> letter.

Home Care Agencies providing homemaker or personal care services must distribute the letter to workers by **March 2, 2020**.

Distribution through at least two notification methods is required. Notification methods include but are not limited to text messages, emails, phone calls, letters, posters, notice with pay statements, etc. Agencies must document receipt of the letter by the employee.

Agencies are encouraged to provide specific details to employees regarding the compensation increase and minimum wage as authorized by Colorado Revised Statute number 25.5-6-1601 et seq., C.R.S. (2019).
