
General Description


- Outpatient Speech-Language Pathology (SLP, or speech therapy) is a State Plan benefit available to children and adults.
- It consists of speech therapy services.
- Providers are licensed speech-language pathologists and their supervised assistants.
- Utilization is distinct from speech therapy services available through the Home Health benefit and school-based services; however the treatment is comparable as the same providers may work in any of those settings.

Additional Details

- State Plan, fee-for-service
- Requires a physician/nurse order and 90 day treatment plan increments
- No annual limit
- Children have rehabilitative and Habilitative therapies covered (acute and chronic)
- Adults only have rehabilitative therapies covered (acute)
 - > Adults on the ACA Medicaid Plan have Habilitative therapies covered too. Requires a PAR.





Utilizer and Provider Counts




—Utilizer Count —Provider Count


Utilizer Count to Total Enrolled




Utilizer Trends by Age Group




Utilization by Age Group




Demographic Comparison
