Colorado Gaming Regulation 47.1-313 provides, in pertinent part:

The licensed gaming premises must be clearly marked as such so that the patrons of each retail gaming establishment can readily discern the licensed premises.

The Division of Gaming will soon be inspecting each retail licensed establishment to ensure compliance with this regulation. This inspection will involve comparing the scale drawing of the proposed licensed gaming area submitted as part of each retail license application with the clearly marked gaming area in the licensed retail establishment. Division of Gaming personnel, local officials and the public must be able to see where the licensed gaming area is located. All slot machines, poker and blackjack tables, and all dealers and patrons playing these devices must be situated in the licensed gaming area.

Licensees are reminded to double-check their compliance with this regulation, as violation of Regulation 47.1-313 could result in sanctions being imposed.
