Colorado casinos are reminded of a regulatory change that goes into effect November 1.

Gaming Regulation 47.1-405(4), which was recently amended by the Colorado Limited Gaming Control Commission, provides:

Each retail, manufacturer, and distributor licensee must report to both the local Division office and the Division's Denver office on a form or other medium required by the division the movement of slot machines, poker tables, and blackjack tables. This notification must be made by both the recipient and sender of devices <u>on a weekly activity basis</u> identifying any movement of devices to and from any location for that week. (*emphasis added*)

Casinos are further reminded that when corresponding with the Division's Denver (Lakewood) office, they must use the Division's unique -1496 zip+4 code to ensure delivery. The proper address is:
