The Colorado Limited Gaming Control Commission has repeatedly expressed concern with traffic safety on the mountain roads in and around the communities of Black Hawk, Central City and Cripple Creek. Consequently, the Commission is determined to hold persons licensed by it to a high standard of conduct on the roadways.

The Commission therefore wishes to remind the industry that it will closely examine any traffic incident involving alcohol or controlled substances, and any traffic record showing a pattern of disregard for the law. This includes individuals holding licenses or applying for gaming licenses. Such incidents could bring disciplinary action from the Commission which may include suspension or revocation of a gaming license, and/or a monetary penalty.

All license holders should be aware of the Commission's desire to keep the gaming industry free from controversy of any type. Good judgment concerning the use of alcohol and driving is very important at all times, but especially crucial in an arena where any problems are examined very closely. Your cooperation in this matter is appreciated.
